



The Chicago Course on Preaching



Would you like to dig deeper into what you are learning at this Workshop? The *Chicago Course on Preaching* (CCP) might be for you. It is a church-based, residential program to train men and women for Word-centered ministry. We have four groups of people in mind:

1. PRE-SEMINARY

The CCP is an introduction to Word ministry for capable men and women who are engaged in teaching the Bible. It can help them test their fitness for a vocational calling.

2. POST-SEMINARY

The CCP is a helpful finishing school for men and women who are at the beginning of vocational Word ministry. Our narrow focus will help those who sense a need for more training in preaching and teaching.

3. EXPERIENCED MINISTERS AND LEADERS

The CCP will assist those who have been engaged in ministry for some time, but who desire supplemental training to further the work they do. In this way, it can be an aid to those in alternative forms of training.

4. INTERNATIONAL TRAINERS

The CCP will serve as a model for ministers from around the world who need additional training and who desire to bring such training back to their home contexts.

LOCATION

The *Chicago Course* is located in the historic Hyde Park neighborhood of Chicago.

COURSE OPTIONS:

- *Part Time*: two-year program, two days per week (Monday and Tuesday or Thursday and Friday), giving ample time for application and training in a local church
- *Full Time*: one-year intensive, four days per week (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday), accelerated training
- *Modular*: three years in duration, consisting in one eleven-week term per year with classes four days per week, allowing for a dedicated time of study away from the local church
